For example, detecting traffic jams from GPS signals, detecting abrupt increase of people in a particular square of a town from mobile activity, etc. The goal is to develop streaming algorithms to detect burst events from GPS and GSM signals **Objectives:** Develop algorithms for detection of bursts of events from data streams.
