Work Area: Knowledge Management in the Aeronautics Industry

Project overview: The E4Value project assesses technological advances, business configurations and value chains in modern aeronautics, within a context of increasing complexity and uncertainty. Particular focus is put on the Portuguese case, with the ultimate goal of understanding (and contributing to) the creation and evolution of an aeronautics cluster in the country and securing the role of Portuguese firms as centers of excellence in aeronautics.

Objectives: The objective of this research grant is to compare knowledge management practices of international associations in aeronautics, and after analyzing the results achieved in E4Value project, generate recommendations for knowledge management to support the development of the Portuguese aeronautics industry.

Academic Qualifications: Masters in Information Science, Industrial Management, Information Engineering or similar

Minimum Profile required: Competences on information and knowledge management. Fluency in English (spoken and written).
