Work Area: Asset Management

Project overview: With the increasing age of assets related to operational functions, asset management has become increasingly more relevant. There is a need to extract the most value from the assets before they are retired from their functions. This project is part of an ongoing endeavor to create an advanced data-based and conditional-monitoring maintenance system to optimize predictive maintenance policies and reduce future O&M costs and risks. The work will be developed in collaboration with companies of the utility sector.

Objectives: Definition and implementation of a methodology for the evaluation of the technical condition of assets; Definition and implementation of a methodology for the prognosis of the technical condition of assets; Design and implementation of a multi-criteria methodology to optimize maintenance actions taking into account costs and risks.
