Work Area:	Information systems, health systems, health care management, hospital logistics, operations research
Project overview:	The KNOWLOGIS project consists of an intelligent dashboard capable of monitoring hospital information systems, constantly on the lookout for efficiency gains in day-to-day operations, in particular inventory management, operations management, hospital supply and medicine circuit, budgeting, procurement, etc. The candidate will be developing an use case to be integrated in the dashboard.
Objectives:	To develop and enhance a method (data mining, machine learning, etc.) for identifying potential opportunities for efficiency gains using data coming from the hospital's information systems. To devise, or adapt, a model based on simulation, optimization or an heuristic for addressing the problem identified.

Academic Qualifications:	Master Degree in Engineering, Economy/Management, Computer Sciences and related areas.
Minimum Profile required:	Experience in software development and engineering, algorithms. Analytical skills.
Preference factors:	Research or working experience in the fields of health care, information systems or operations research.
