Job description:

Work Area: Communication paradigms studies on 360 videos.

Project overview: The AV360 project, supported by the Google Digital News Initiative, focuses on the study and creation of tools for editing and viewing 360 ° videos with dynamic annotations for immersive journalism. The selected candidate will participate in the creation of pieces using 360° videos, studying new forms of journalistic narrative using the functional prototypes already existing in Virtual Reality. The candidate must carry out comparative studies and participate in the project dissemination plan.

Objectives: -Study paradigms of narratives in 360° videos for journalism; -Study interaction metaphors for interactive 360 video exploration; -Make a wide set of 360 video pieces. -Evaluate users satisfaction and their ability to use prototypes from the point of view of the editor.

Minimum Profile required:	MSc's degree in Communication Sciences, Multimedia or similar. Experience in creation of journalistic pieces, video edition and web environments.
Preference factors:	Are preferred factors the experience with video editing tools and 360 videos
